PRIMARY SCHOOL CHILDREN TO HELP MARK DONCASTER HILL MILESTONE

Manningham Mayor Cr Bill Larkin will join children from the Doncaster Primary School and the developer of the Southpoint Apartments, Mr Stan De Mangos, in unveiling a plaque to mark commemorate the completion of the first development on Doncaster Hill.

Cr Larkin said the past few months have seen significant activity associated with Doncaster Hill with favourable planning decisions and the completion of the first development, Southpoint Apartments.
